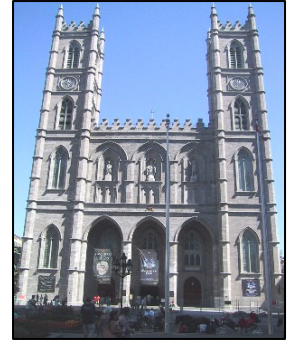


# Montreal 2008

## Tour Features Include:

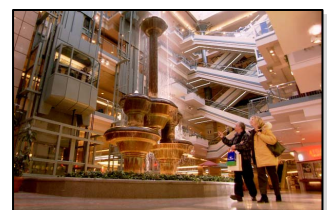
## Historic Tours

### Tour Rates

#### Student Rate:

\$425.00 per student based on quad occupancy [four students per room] accommodations.

#### Parent Chaperone Rate:

\$425.00 per adult based on double occupancy [two adults per room] accommodations.

### Deposit Schedule

1. To secure your reservation on a definite basis, a \$125.00 per person deposit is required and is due on or before **Wednesday, February 6, 2008**. Please make checks payable to C.J. Hooker Middle School.
2. Second deposit of \$150.00 per person is due on or before **Wednesday, February 27, 2008**.
3. Final payment of \$150.00 per person is due on or before **Wednesday, March 26, 2008**.

★ Please understand that Jumpstreet Tours requires deposits from groups within two weeks of securing reservations.

Should you be unable to pay the full deposit by **Wednesday, February 6**, please contact Mr. Lewis or Mrs. Chapman.

★ In addition, we will make an attempt to assist students financially to assure that those wishing to participate in the trip be afforded with the opportunity to do so.

Students needing financial assistance are asked and encouraged to speak with Mr. Lewis before January 30 in order for us to make necessary arrangements.

To secure your reservation on a definite basis, you must return:

- ✓ the signed reservation form (attached page)
- ✓ the student field trip conduct code form (attached page)
- ✓ \$125.00 per person deposit (by check only)

Initial deposits and accompanying reservation/field trip forms must be handed personally to Mr. Lewis or Mrs. Chapman no later than **Wednesday, February 6, 2008**. Please act fast, as there are a limited number of spaces available!
